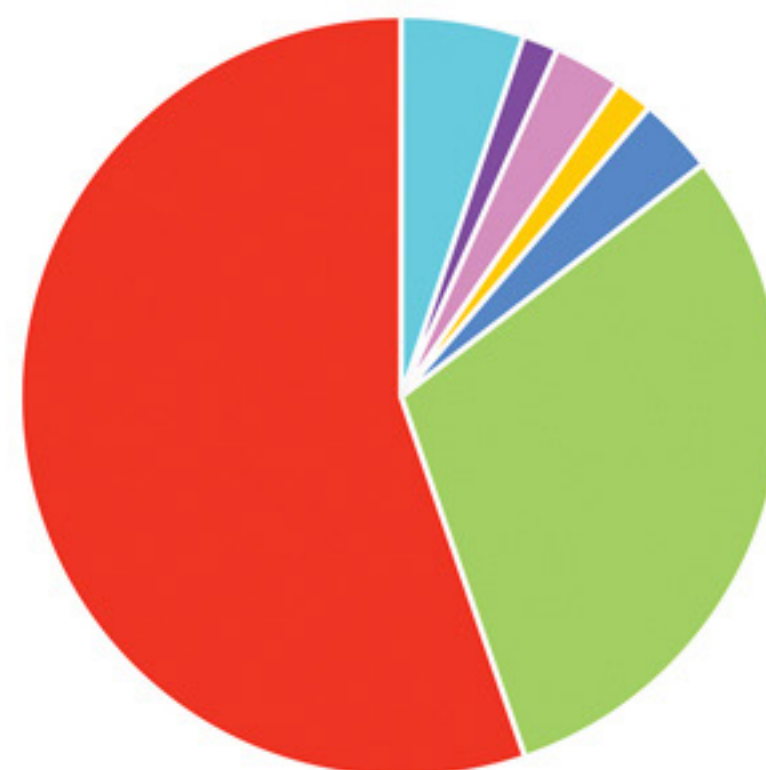

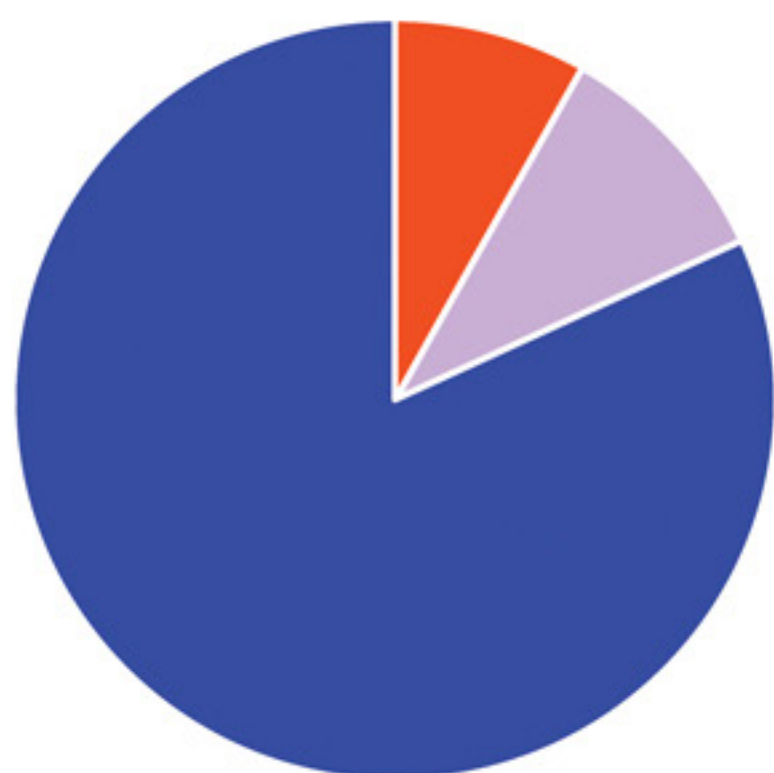

ADVOCACY

NANCY LITZ

Although I've never lacked strong public policy opinions – yes, I was one of those Vietnam-era protesters – my busy life as a single mom of three often kept me from researching and acting on issues that mattered to me.

That began to change when my twin daughters became leaders in the new Gay-Straight Alliance at their school, working on bullying protections for LGBTQ teens. I watched proudly from the sidelines as they spoke at school board meetings, led regional GSA workshops and joined PROMO lobby trips to Jefferson City.

When they headed to college I felt obligated to pick up where they left off. On my first trip to Jeff City I was so terrified I actually slipped away from my lobbying group and wandered the streets until bus departure time. But on my second trip – Planned Parenthood this time – I met a group of smart, articulate NCJW women on the bus, and the rest is history.

I joke that NCJW taught me to share my opinions without the obscene gestures ... but really they have taught me so much more. From policy details to persuasive strategies, from writing letters to the editor to building coalition relationships. They've shown me how our service projects can meet community needs today while they inspire us to advocate for policies to eliminate those needs in the future.

I'm excited to "re-enlist" as VP Advocacy and hopefully help other women find and fine-tune their own voices in support of policies that align with our Jewish values of repairing the world and seeing each person as made in the image of God.

And I'm grateful for you – members and supporters – who make our advocacy efforts so impactful.

Keep up the great work – there's plenty more to do!

Andrea is currently on the Executive Team as Secretary and on the Board of Directors.

Steve, a retired RubinBrown partner, became involved with BTSS as a personal shopper, which led to his interest in purchasing the items given out to children at the store. The family goes out after Thanksgiving dinner to buy hundreds of coats, smiling ear to ear, knowing that so many children are going to be helped. Steve and his son Todd, started the annual Men's Event, to raise funds for Back to School! Store because they also wanted to get their friends involved in supporting NCJW and BTSS. Steve also currently serves on the NCJW Advisory Council.

Todd has volunteered at Back to School! Store for several years, and upon meeting his wife, Jessica, the tradition continued. He and Jessica volunteer at BTSS every year and Todd escorts Fredbird around the store!

In 2014, Sherri and Steve were honored with the NCJW St. Louis Section Community Service Award.

NANCY SITEMAN

I became a member NCJW thirty-four years ago. It was 1983 and I was pregnant with my son, David, who is now married with two children (Aviva and Coby) of his own! At that time, NCJW had an evening group, primarily for women in their 20's and 30's. I joined, hoping to hang out with other pregnant women/new mothers and make some friends, share experiences. Those friendships have lasted to this day. My mother, Ruth Siteman, has been an NCJW member for more than 60 years. She was president of the Councilettes, a teen group in the 1940's and later started the Planned Parenthood/NCJW volunteer partnership in the 1960's. She remains an active volunteer and generous funder of the organization today. I followed in her legacy - that of building strong leadership for women and making a difference for all with our community service projects.

When I was a member of the New Project Development committee 18 years ago, the idea for the Back to School! Store was first proposed. What a success that turned out to be! I went on to become a board member and then President of our section in 2004. It was such an exciting and challenging time, as it is for every president. That's when Ellen Alper was hired and our section evolved from an entirely volunteer organization to one with a professional staff. Later, I had the opportunity to be on another new project committee, where Kids Community Closet was developed. In 2008, we started with two closets and today, Kids Community Closet serves students in 23 schools, and 8,000 children a year have access to them.

Post-presidency, my focus has been on fundraising and expanding community service and leadership. As an early member of the Hannah G. Solomon Society, I believe that a financial commitment from our members and the community is vital to NCJW's growth and impact in our community. Along with my mother, we started the Ruth and Nancy Siteman Leadership Legacy Tribute Fund to help with ongoing funding for NCJW's leadership programs. I am thrilled that NCJW provides so many opportunities for women to gain valuable leadership skills to use in our section and with other community organizations as well. It is so important to invest in our most valuable assets - the women who volunteer their time, talent and resources to support our mission!

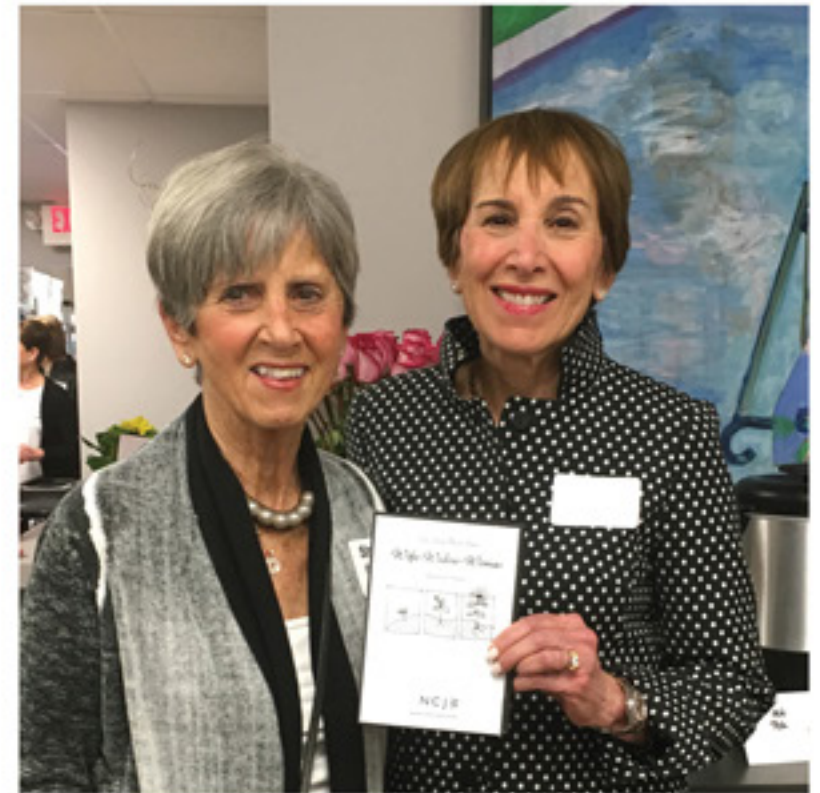
