Help Protect Trans Kids! Tell Your Missouri State Senator to Vote NO on SB 843

<u>SB 843</u>, Senator Mike Moon's dangerous health care ban targeting transgender youth, has PASSED out of the Senate Seniors, Families, Military and Veteran Affairs Committee.

This bill seeks to ban life-saving, medically necessary and affirming health care for transgender youth. The bill outlines several specific avenues of safe, developmentally appropriate comprehensive care for transgender and gender-expansive youth that would be banned and whose providers would face punishable consequences.



This bill overlooks standard best practices backed by the <u>American Academy of Pediatrics</u> and other mainstream medical associations and penalizes healthcare professionals for doing their jobs — making collaborative decisions with parents and families that help affirm, celebrate, and save the lives of our most vulnerable young people.

It is a month to highlight and make an extra effort to create awareness about the importance of strengthening families and preventing child abuse and neglect. As one of the founders of the Child Abuse Prevention Program at JFS, NCJWSTL is proud to amplify this vital issue.

For our April Lunch and Learn, we are excited to welcome Jeff Dion of the Zero Abuse Project. Jeff is an attorney, survivor, and nationally recognized victim advocate. He comes to the Zero Abuse Project after more than twenty years with the National Center for Victims of Crime, where he served as Director of the National Crime Victim Bar Association. He has led efforts to reform civil statutes of limitation to expand access to justice for victims of child sex abuse.

From 2002 to 2010, Jeff served as a gubernatorial appointee to the Virginia Criminal Justice Services Board, where he chaired the Victim Services Advisory Committee. He has received numerous awards including the 2006 Ronald Wilson Reagan Public Policy Award presented by the U.S. Department of Justice for outstanding innovation and commitment to crime victim legislation. He earned his undergraduate and a law degree from George Mason University in Fairfax, Virginia, and an Executive Certificate in Nonprofit Management from Georgetown University.
