HHB provided 50 microloans, helping women and families further their financial independence. We continued to form strategic collaborations with new agencies over the course of the year. We continue to be in communication with our partner schools throughout the school year, supplying them with the items they request. Our liaisons not only deliver the items requested, they also help put items away and keep the closets organized.

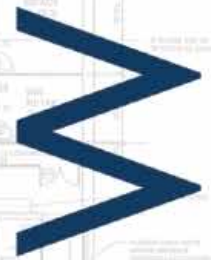

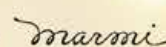
