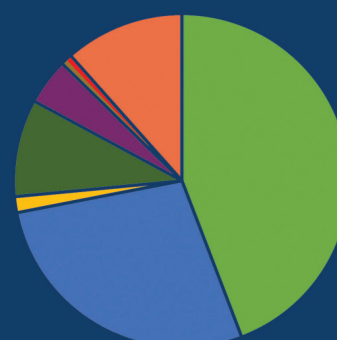

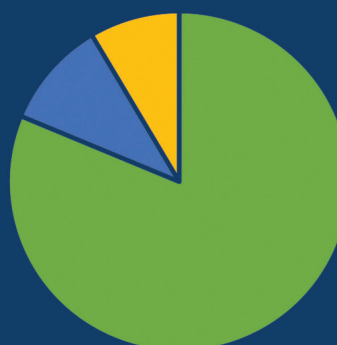

ADVOCACY



NCJWSTL was instrumental in getting Amendment 3 on the ballot for the November 2024 election. NCJWSTL gathered 15,000 signatures and notarized over 900 people's petitions. We also organized notaries across Missouri.



NCJWSTL has been a notary site for the People Not Politicians referendum petition fighting the illegal gerrymandering of CD 5.



The PATH (Protect Abortion, Truth, and Healthcare) Coalition, which will lead local organizations in fighting the effort to make abortion illegal in Missouri, was formed.



NCJWSTL has taken over the Court Watch program which ensures best practices are followed to protect victims of domestic violence in Family Court.



Partnered with Beacon Health to get our semi-annual birth control supply bill passed.

COMMUNITY IMPACT



Healing Hearts Bank achieved a milestone: We've provided over \$175,000 in loans! As of June 17, 2025, 361 loans totaling \$177,392 have been issued.



73 vouchers totaling \$5,700 for The Resale Shop were distributed to those individuals and families facing hardship.



Jean Stein Bloch Wife Widow Woman program expanded to four sessions and added a new therapist and co-facilitator to the rotation. Our Outreach Committee has been meeting regularly and planning upcoming alumni programming events.

30 Kids Community Closets, serving 34 schools, distributed essential items to students that needed them most:

THE RESALE SHOP

-  Annual sales at The Resale Shop during 2024-2025 grew 24%.
-  10,506 people made donations to The Resale Shop during 2024-2025, a 16% increase.
-  178,925 items were sold, with profits supporting women, children, and families, a 3.4% increase.
-  Couturier, the largest fundraising event of the year, delivered a 15% sales increase.
-  The Resale Shop was voted "Finalist" in three categories by voters in St. Louis Magazine's A-List Awards: Best Resale Shop, Best Shoe Store, and Best Activewear Store

TIME & TALENT

-  1,458 total members including 525 Regular, Supporting, and Sustaining members and 868 Lifetime members.
-  A record number of 18 participants attended the 10 session Leadership Class, strengthening their leadership skills to be used at NCJWSTL and throughout the St. Louis community.
-  Dana Sandweiss received the Hannah G Solomon award along with six section award honorees for their incredible service to the community at our annual Celebrating Women event.
-  Volunteer Hours: 12,000+ members and supporters donated their efforts to supporting women, children, and families in our community.

HIGHLIGHTS

-  When the tornado hit St. Louis in May 2025, NCJWSTL partnered with the St. Louis Public Schools Foundation to deliver and purchase toiletries, air mattresses, sheets, towels, phone chargers, lanterns, sleeping bags, toiletries, hotel stays and more. Our members, volunteers, and community donated close to \$20,000 worth of in-kind donations to assist with the absolute devastation and to help alleviate some of the burden for the tornado victims.
-  Our partnership with Royal Banks of Missouri allowed us to distribute 10,000 copies of our Family Resource Guide to our partner agencies, Back to School! Store attendees, Kids Community Closet schools, and throughout the community. Thank you to Royal Banks of Missouri for your generous support!
